

- FINAL CAB MEETING. One meeting remaining, the ABSI CAB process will culminate with the final meeting on November 29, 2023 when the CAB will approve the organizational framework for *Partners for a Resilient Apalachicola Bay* (CAB Successor Group), and adopt the CAB Draft Final Report and Recommendations for the Apalachicola Bay System Ecosystem-Based Adaptive Management and Restoration Plan.

REVIEW OF THE ABSI CAB PROCESS

COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS

- CAB process started in 2019 and will conclude in 2023.
- First CAB meeting was held on October 30, 2019.
- 28 CAB meetings concluding with the November 29, 2023 meeting.
- 4 Oystermen's Workshops.
- 4 Community Workshops.
- COVID prevented additional Community Workshops planned for 2020 – Early 2022 (The CAB met virtually from May 2020 – January 2022).
